Eddie Crowe

Our second inductee is Eddie Crowe. Eddie was a 3 year varsity starter for Carlisle in basketball. In his junior and senior years he scored double figures 44 out of 46 games. He played in 65 varsity games during his career. He scored in double figures 50 out of the 65 games. He scored 1,109 total points for 17 points per game career average.

During his senior year his team had a perfect 9-0 record and won the SWBL championship. During his career he also played on 3 sectional championship teams and a district runner up team. Some individual honors his junior year include player of the year in SWBL, player of the year district 15 and second team All State. His senior year honors were player of the year SWBL, player of the year district 15, player of the year southwest region and first team All State. He played in the Ohio North South All Star game in Canton, Ohio where he was the cocaptain of the team.

During his career at Wright State, Eddie played in 110 games as a starter. His team was 20-8 his sophomore season, 25-4 his junior season and 24-3 his senior season. Eddie played in 3 NCAA Division 2 tournaments. He averaged 11 points per game his senior season, 10 his junior season, and 14 his sophomore season. He scored a total of 1,124 points and approximately 430 assists during his college career which made him the leader in assists at that time. Eddie is a member of the Wright State Wall of Fame in basketball.
