- 1) Absence Notes/Calls Parents, please be sure to send in a note or call the school EVERY TIME that your son or daughter is absent from school. 4) Drop-Off / Pick-Up – If parents are dropping off in the morning, please recall that the times to do this are 7:50 am – 8:20 am. Afternoon pickup occurs starting at 3:05 pm (2:20 pm on Wednesdays).

We appreciate your patience when dropping off and picking up. We do ask that drivers pull as far up along the sidewalk as possible when dropping off or picking up – this will allow more students to be dropped off at once and will speed the entire process up.
