SMOKE SIGNALS:

- 1) Absence Notes/Calls Parents, please be sure to send in a note or call the school EVERY TIME that your son or daughter is absent from school. If he/she visits a doctor (or dentist), pick up a note at the office and turn it in to school (these types of absences are always 'Excused'). Parents may write a 'Parent Note' or use a phone call to excuse up to 12 total absence occurrences (doctor's notes are included in this 12) After 12 doctor's notes/parent notes/phone calls, only a doctor's note can excuse an absence. - 2) Communication It is our goal at Alden Brown Elementary to maintain constant communication with our parents. - 4) Drop-Off / Pick-Up If parents are dropping off in the morning, please recall that the times to do this are 8:05 am 8:20 am. Please do not arrive prior to 8:05 am because staff members will need to have access to the lot in order to park. Afternoon pickup occurs starting at 3:05 pm (2:20 pm on Wednesdays).

We appreciate your patience when dropping off and picking up. We do ask that drivers pull as far up along the sidewalk as possible when dropping off or picking up – this will allow more students to be dropped off at once and will speed the entire process up.

- 5) Masks and Distancing Please keep reminding your son or daughter about the importance of wearing their mask (covering their mouth and nose) at all times at school. As difficult as it is, we need to remind students (and adults) about the importance of mask wearing and distancing from others.  - 1-Hour Delay (Wednesday): AM Kindergarten from 9:20-11:20, PM Kindergarten from 12:20-2:20 (NO PRE-SCHOOL ON WEDNESDAYS)
 - **2-Hour Delay (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday)**: AM Pre-School from 10:15-12:23, PM Pre-School from 1:07-3:15; AM Kindergarten 10:20-12:13, PM Kindergarten 1:13-3:05
 - **2-Hour Delay (Wednesday Early Release cancelled)** Early Release will likely be cancelled. If so, we'll use the following schedule: AM Kindergarten from 10:20-12:13; PM Kindergarten 1:13-3:05 (THERE IS NO CLSD PRE-SCHOOL ON WEDNESDAY)

2-Hour Delay (Wednesday – with Early Release) – If Early Release is not cancelled: AM Kindergarten from 10:20-11:50; PM Kindergarten 12:50-2:20 (THERE IS NO CLSD PRE-SCHOOL ON WEDNESDAY)
